


TARGET GROUP

- Empower children to prioritize sustainable development in their lifestyles, behaviours, attitudes, education and their future






WHAT IS NEXT?

International Capacity Building of Teachers -


16 teachers from Sweden, Turkey and Portugal will meet to test the **Gamebox** (e-learning platform) during the alpha test and the **Methodological approach framework** (MAF), improving their skills by sharing the experience with each other:

- Module 1. How to be a sustainable mentor?
- Module 2. How to face environmental challenges?
- Module 3. Let's be sustainable consumers!
- Module 4. I am an energy saver. And you?
- Module 5. How do I efficiently manage my waste?
- Module 6. How to make an economy circle?

MENTORING PROGRAMMES IN Sweden, Portugal and Turkey

- 3 open calls for children's fellowships to be mentors ("Climate Changemakers Warriors" mentoring programme to teach children to be solutionminded, innovative achievers of sustainable practices to become environmental warriors)
- 24 mentors (8 per school) between 6 & 12 years old will be selected in order to develop the mini mentor's programme camp. Mentors will create activities with their peers under supervision of teachers
- 3 mini mentor's programme camp (I per school) will be developed by children with support of teachers

MINI MENTOR'S Programme Camp

Between 20 - 22

 activities/mini projects (7 per school) will be organized (face – to - face & online)

involving 240 primary students (80per school) as green changemakers
