Professional development


- Started in 2005. A million users registered since then
- More than 40 countries take part in eTwinning
- For the school sector; pre-school, primary and secondary education – and for teacher initial training
- No funding, no reporting
- Support provided via a National Support Organisation (NSO's) in each country



# Registering on the European School Education Platform (ESEP) – and joining eTwinning

- Create an EU-login for ESEP – if you work in a school, also click *Join eTwinning*
- ESEP users are not validated
- eTwinning users are validated by the National Support Organisations


